The Phonics Screening Check for Year 1 pupils starts on the week beginning 10th June. These are statutory assessments which all Year 1 pupils in the UK are required to do. These checks are to ensure that children have learnt decoding and blending skills to a sufficient standard so that they can read with fluency.





- Read every night with your child at home.
- Encourage blending by sweeping your hand under the word when your child has sounded it out.
- Ensure your child is well rested the week of the check.


