On Friday 14th June, our Caritas Ambassadors are hosting a Summer Fair from 3.15pm until 4pm.


There will be lots of great stalls, including

Phonics Screening Check

The Phonics Screening Check for Year 1 pupils starts on the **week beginning 10th June**. These are statutory assessments which all Year 1 pupils in the UK are required to do. These checks are to ensure that children have learnt decoding and blending skills to a sufficient standard so that they can read with fluency.



How can I support my child to prepare for the check?

- Read every night with your child at home.
- Encourage blending by sweeping your hand under the word when your child has sounded it out.
- Ensure your child is well rested the week of the check.
